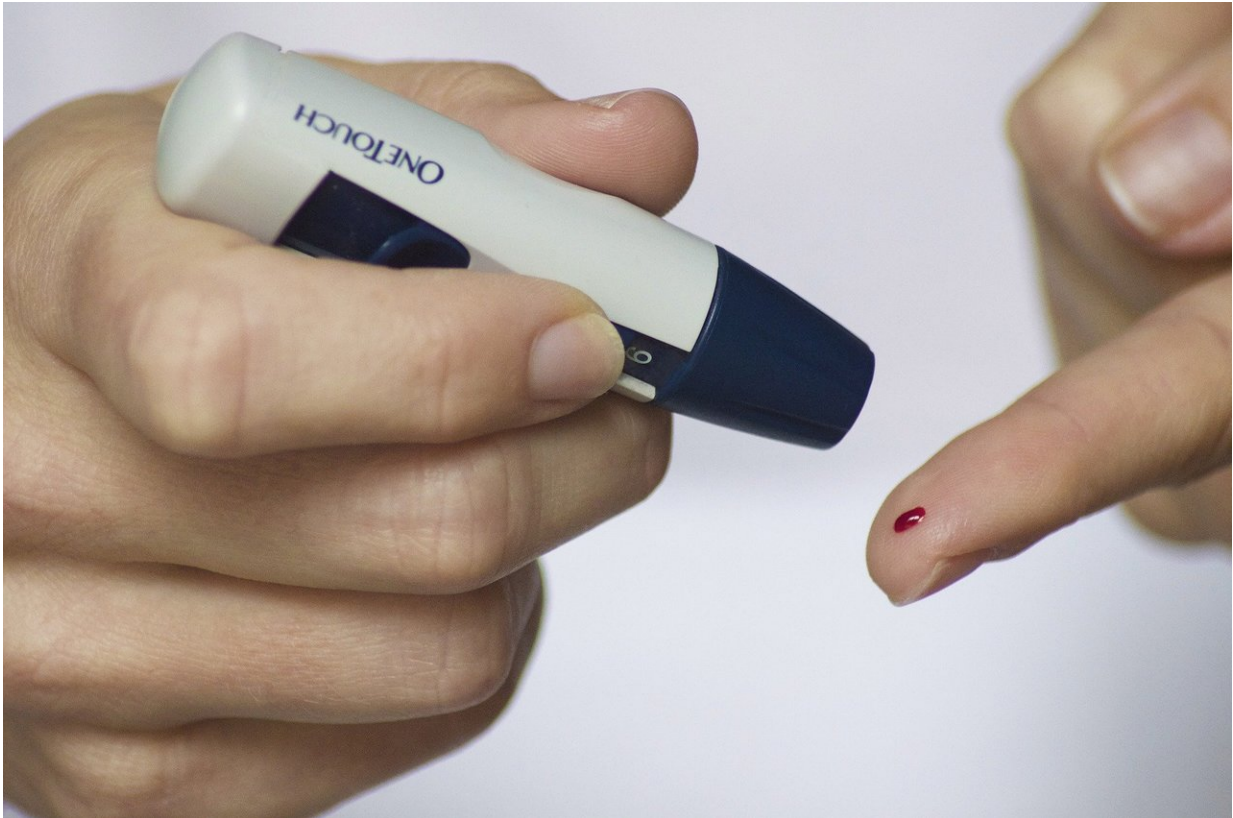


Treating type 2 diabetes and heart failure
