

## Baseline patient characteristics may predict psoriasis course

(HealthDay)—Patient characteristics at onset can help to estimate the long-term course of psoriasis with good discriminatory power, according to a study published online April 14 in *JAMA Dermatology*.

Axel Svedbom, from the Karolinska Institutet in Stockholm, and colleagues sought to describe the clinical course of <u>psoriasis</u> and identify possible indicators of long-term outcomes among a noninterventional cohort of patients enrolled between 2001 and 2005 and followed for 10 years. The <u>analysis</u> included 721 patients (?15 years) with recent-onset psoriasis (
